Course costs are \$50.00 for each participant and payment **MUST** accompany registration. This excellent presentation will acquaint you with the following material:

Food service legislation and inspection
Proper temperatures and storage techniques
Food poisoning and prevention
Pest control management

There will be a 50-question, multiple-choice examination at the end of the course. Everyone who scores at least 70 percent on this test will be awarded a Food Service Certificate, valid for five years, that will be recognized throughout Ontario as meeting the requirements of the food service training standards of the Province's Ministry of Health and Long Term Care.
