Pool or spa must be closed when:

1. Chemical levels are not correct.
2. Emergency equipment is not available.
3. Circulation system is not working.
4. There is no qualified operator available on the premises to ensure that the requirements of the Public Pools Regulation 565 are being met.
5. Pool fouling (vomit or fecal matter).
6. Loose or missing drain covers.
7. Emergency phone not operating.
8. Any other condition that constitutes an immediate health hazard.

Pool must be closed when the black disc, 150 mm in diameter, on a white background located at the greatest depth is not clearly visible from 9 metres away.

Spa must be closed when the water clarity does not allow the lowest water outlet drain in the spa to be visible when the spa water is in a non-turbulent state.
